

Creating a Food Chain Using the Peregrine Falcon

Objective: Student will construct and label the parts of a food chain using the Peregrine Falcon as the predator.

Directions: Cut out the parts of the food chain below.

On a piece of paper, draw a falcon habitat. This habitat can be either the steep cliffs of a gorge or tall buildings in a city.

Glue on your picture of falcon habitat the pictures of parts of the food chain from below.

Label prey, predator, producer.

Draw arrows from the producer to the prey to the predator to show how energy is transferred.

Make sure you put a title on the top of your food chain drawing.
