2008 SCIENCE JOURNAL
APRIL 1st TO JUNE 20th**

Objective: Student will observe and record interactions between a living organisms, the falcons, and physical environment.

Directions: You are to make two entries a week in your journal. You will look at the bird cam and write what you see on that day. You can make your entries from the school computer or at home. If you are doing it from home, the web address is www.rfalconcam.com. Go to the left side, and click on multi-view.

Each entry must have the following information. Please be sure you include all this information or it will not count. Write your information in complete sentences.

- Date and time
- Weather at that time of day
- Description of what you see the bird, or birds, doing
- Which camera view you used

Here is an example of what an entry should look like:

April 2, 2008 9:45 a.m.

Today's weather is sunny and warm. It is 65 degrees Fahrenheit. We might have rain tonight.

When I looked at camera view #2, I see one egg in the nest. There are no other birds around at this time.
